
Plan of Action & Outcome

Plan of Action	Achievement / Outcome
Proposal for initiating value-added courses	A total of six value-added courses were offered during the session, one each from Botany, Chemistry, Commerce, History, Philosophy and Zoology departments. Encouraging response from students observed.
Community related works and upholding the social commitment of the institution.	Faculty members and the students participated in several programs related to community services under the hood of Pabitra Kumar Sen Memorial Forum for Community Work. Five such programs were organized (on 21/09/2022, 24/11/2022, 15/12/2022, 23/02/2023 and 05/04/2023) during the current session. Training the local populace in Mushroom Culture was also undertaken during this session.
Career advancement of teachers via the Career Advancement Scheme (CAS)	Proposals for career advancement of 23 teachers of the college were sent, in three phases during this session, to the Dept. of Higher Education, Govt. of WB for CAS based promotion.
Maintaining academic and co-curricular activities alongside the regular classroom teaching.	Seminars/webinars were organized via direct departmental participation as well as through the alumni engagement (Physics Alumni). Several important days were commemorated and celebrated throughout the year (International Women's Day, International Mother Tongue Day, National AIDS

Monitoring and motivating the progress of the DBT Star College Scheme.	Jhargram Raj College has been awarded the DBT Star Status, vide an e-mail from Dr. Garima Gupta, dated 14/10/2022.
Engaging directly with college administration to work for the overall development of the college infra and provide upgraded logistic support.	Several infrastructural works related to the maintenance and upgradation of the extant structures done in college buildings and hostels. Furniture were upgraded, and electrical installations were overhauled. AMCs for purified drinking water facilities in the college as well as the hostels were done.

Action taken

1. The IQAC took initiative to start the value-added courses in the college during the academic session 2022-2023. A total of **six** value-added courses have been floated in this academic session and the IQAC has proposed to increase the number of these courses. The response from the students in these courses have been found to be quite encouraging.
2. As a part of continuous engagement with the society and the related outreach activities, the IQAC continued its efforts, via the Pabitra Kumar Sen Memorial Forum for Community Work. A total of **five** such programs were organized during the current session.
3. The IQAC framed the proposals for financial assistance for hostel maintenance and development, the upgradation of extant the Wi-Fi facility in the campus, overhaul and annual maintenance of the electrical installations, thorough cleaning of the drinking water facilities, etc.
4. The IQAC undertook efforts for the career advancement of teachers of the college through the Career Advancement Scheme (CAS). A total of **23** faculty members have been benefitted by the CAS during the session 2022-2023.
5. As a part of the teaching-learning process, the IQAC motivated the academic departments to organize seminars/webinars via direct departmental participation as well as through the alumni engagement. The IQAC also actively engaged itself in commemorating and celebrating different occasions throughout the year (International Women's Day, International Mother Tongue Day, National AIDS Day, Foundation Day, etc.). As one of its best practices, the IQAC worked (with the Dr. Sudip Kumar Das, Dept. of Botany) on the mushroom culture training program.
