

Pre-requisites: Ability to speak about familiar things in basic sentences in English (Although this will be recapitulated briefly in the course) .

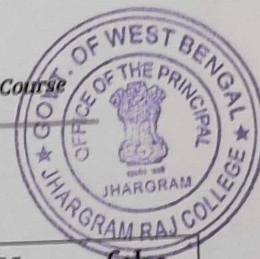
Syllabus:

4. Conversational Skills and Public Speaking and Presentation
 - a. Individual presentations on chosen topics
 - b. Small Debate on various topics
