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### PART – B: PLAN OF ACTION AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT FOR THE ENTIRE ACADEMIC YEAR

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#### Action taken

Based on the feedback and its consequent analysis, it was felt that several issues needed attention in view of the extended lockdown and the immediate effects of college re-opening post lockdown. The IQAC suggested that during the time when the college operated on a mixed mode, a hygienic arrangement of food via the college canteen was made. In addition, sanitizer dispensing machines were installed in strategic locations of the college premises to ensure an overall well-being of the students and staff visiting the college. The PWD, under the suggestion of the college authority undertook necessary civil and electrical works to maintain the extant facilities and make them operational. The drinking water facilities were cleaned under the annual maintenance contract by the appropriate vendor. The laboratories of the Chemistry department were upgraded by installing a new LPG pipeline and the old dilapidated setup was written off. The IQAC ensured a dynamic website update in terms of the publication of notices, instructions and updates for the benefit of the student under lock down.

1. In view of the prevailing pandemic situation and also keeping in view the fact that the academic atmosphere of the college has to be preserved, the IQAC of Jhargram Raj College has suggested to continuously keep on conducting online classes using the available platforms like Google Classroom, Google Meet, Zoom etc., and ensured the need for continuous effort to carry forward the teaching-learning process.

2. The IQAC also pointed out the need to regularly conduct and organize webinars and training programs for the students and teachers during the pandemic situation. In addition, meetings of Board of Studies for PG departments were held in online mode. Examinations were taken, followed by evaluation through online and the departments were requested to keep records of online classes and examination.

3. The IQAC suggested that a teachers' training workshop be organized on the digital platform to help teachers cope up with the online teaching practices. A workshop aimed at training teachers has been organized by the college on 23rd and 24th August, 2020.

4. The IQAC suggested the college authority to procure its own Google suite license for having a better and more widespread connectivity and access for the digital platforms.

5. The IQAC motivated the NSS unit of the college and the Physics Alumni Association to come up with extension activities. As an extension activity aimed at community development, the IQAC, along with the Chemistry departments of the college, conducted the mass production of hand sanitizers in collaboration with the district administration of Jhargram and the local NGOs.

6. The IQAC strongly recommended the college to pray for administrative approval for providing sanitization program for the college periodically, for purchasing sanitizer sprayer machines, dispensers, thermal scanners, masks, gloves, etc. for current situation.

7. The IQAC promoted a one-to-one correspondence between the teachers and the students keeping in view the mental health of the students during the pandemic situation.



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#### Implementation by college

1. All the departments have organised lectures, workshops, webinars, training programs, etc. in collaboration with the IQAC, Jhargram Raj College during the period. More than 25 webinars were hosted during this period.

2. Motivated by IQAC, extension works were conducted. Almost 60 economically underprivileged Lodha and Shabar families have been provided with essential food items in Gira, Pukuria on 20/06/2020 by the Physics Alumni Association of Jhargram Raj College. Continuing the same in Bhalukkhuliya, Kanko, Binpur, several tribal families were benefitted on 28/06/2020.

3. As per the suggestion made by the IQAC, the college authority has waived a sizeable portion of the examination fees for all the postgraduate students. The authority has also waived the fees of all applicants to the post graduate courses.

4. In response to the prayer made by the college to Government for sanitizing & purchase of relevant article to combat covid-19, an amount of RS. 99,709.00 (Ninety Nine Thousand, Seven Hundred and nine only) has been sanctioned from Assistant Secretary, and approved by Principal Secretary, HE Department, Govt. on West Bengal.
5. Sixteen (16) teachers have been encouraged to attend different FDP in online mode.

4 Two value added courses was organized by Department of Zoology, via online platform.




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#### **PART – F: MISCELLANEOUS**

#### + THE UNIVERSITY&INTERNAL EXAMINATION

- Due to the pandemic situation, and a continuous lockdown throughout the country, the University Examinations were held in the online mode. The college conducted the examinations in adherence to the examination guidelines laid down by Vidyasagar University. The examinations and the evaluations for Undergraduate and Postgraduate courses were held in the online mode. Both patterns of the curricula, namely, the CBCS system (for Honours students of Science Departments and all the Post Graduate Departments) as well as Annual system (for students pursuing Humanities and Commerce, and those students of science departments slated to clear their backlogs). This was the first batch for the CBCS system, as it was implemented since 2017-18 in the undergraduate level. The first final examination (533 UG students and 73 PG students) and the pass percentage was 100%. The University examination for intermediate semester was held in April 2021 in the online mode. The final semester examination for 2021 is yet to be held.
- Internal Examination was held for UG Semester I, III, and V from25.03.2021to 01.04.2021via online mode.
- **4** OTHERS ACTIVITY
- The year of 2020-2021 was challenging in regard to sustaining the quality development efforts.
- The process of promotion of the teachers through the Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) could not be successfully accomplished for the lockdown. Additionally, the Directorate and the Department of Higher Education had to operate with below the optimum number of staff and had to stretch the administrative processes. However, the process of documentation related to the CAS-based promotion was carried out throughout the year.
- It was not possible to organize annual sports.
- Some mandatory activities like distribution of admit cards &mark sheet were done following Covid 19 protocol strictly.
- An "Intra College Online Paragraph Writing Competition on Vector Borne Disease" on the topic 'Dengue Awareness have been organized by the NSS Units of Jhargram Raj College from 20<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2020.
- Flag hoisting ceremony was held on 26<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 on the occasion of Republic day at the college campus following Covid 19 protocol.
