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

Action taken Report

1. The IQAC made sure that on-going work was required to advance the teaching-learning process. The pandemic lockdown situation persisted during this academic year through November 2021 and January 2022. According to the circumstances, the Jhargram Raj College IQAC has recommended that classes be conducted in a hybrid style, which includes both online and offline classes. During the on-going pandemic or even after the college opened, the IQAC encouraged oneonone communication between the teachers and students while keeping in mind the students' mental health.

2. The IQAC also made note of the necessity of setting up sensitization programs for the students and teachers in accordance with the circumstance, including social distance, usage of sanitizers and masks, adherence to the COVID protocol, etc. Additionally, Board of Studies meetings for PG departments were held both online and offline. According to university guidelines, exams were administered, followed by offline and online evaluations. Departments were asked to maintain track of online classes and exams.

3. The IQAC took initiative to address the teachers' outstanding CAS and arrears. IQAC have motivated teachers to participate in different faculty improvement programmes.

4. Students' Satisfaction Survey (SSS) was organized for the first time by the IQAC of Jhargram Raj College during this year. To make the students conversant with the process, the faculty members took an active role to communicate with the students. The SSS for the year 2021-2022 was conducted via e-mail, and the IQAC has proposed to carry out an OTP based SSS from the next academic session.

5. Under the guidance of the IQAC, the departments of Physics and Zoology organized two summer school programs in the online mode during the lockdown period and involved eminent experts in the respective subjects to motivate the students.

Implementation by college

Based on the feedback and its consequent analysis, IQAC suggested making the college functional in a mixed mode, at least for first several months. The IQAC ensured the need for continuous effort to carry forward the teaching-learning process. The IQAC promoted a one-to-one correspondence between the teachers and the students keeping in view the mental health of the students during the ongoing pandemic or even after opening of the college. As a part of this, a sensitization programme was organised for the students and teachers and non-teaching staffs to follow the covid protocol, social distance, use of sanitizers and masks etc.

1. Examinations were taken, followed by evaluation through online and offline following the directives of University and the departments were requested to keep records of online classes and examination.

2. Two summer school programmes were organized via online mode.

3. The PWD was asked to take necessary civil and electrical works to maintain the extant facilities and make them operational.

4. The procedure of screening/selection of four teachers has been processed. Three teachers have received their Govt. orders for promotions. Five teachers have participated in different induction programmes, refresher courses and other courses.

5. An air quality & Noise monitoring station with display board has been installed by West Bengal Pollution control Board on 27.08.2021.

6. Twenty webinars and three seminars were organized by the college. An IPR cell has been established to make the stakeholders sentient about the issue.

THE UNIVERSITY&INTERNAL EXAMINATION
